POLITICALLY EXPOSED PERSONS DETAILED DESCRIPTION

A **foreign PEP** is a person who holds or has ever held one of the following offices or positions in or on behalf of a foreign state: Head of state or head of government; member of the executive council of government or member of a legislature; deputy minister or equivalent rank, ambassador, or the attaché or counsellor of an ambassador; military officer with a rank of general or above; president of a state owned company or a state owned bank; head of a government agency; judge of a supreme court, constitutional court or other court of last resort; or leader or president of a political party represented in a legislature. Once a person is determined to be a foreign PEP, they remain a foreign PEP forever, even after death.

A **domestic PEP** is a person who holds — or has held within the last 5 years — a specific office or position in or on behalf of the Canadian federal government, a Canadian provincial government, or a Canadian municipal government: Governor General, lieutenant governor or head of government; member of the Senate or House of Commons or member of a legislature; deputy minister or equivalent rank; ambassador, or attaché or counsellor of an ambassador; military officer with a rank of general or above; president of a corporation that is wholly owned directly by Her Majesty in right of Canada or a province; head of a government agency; judge of an appellate court in a province, the Federal Court of Appeal or the Supreme Court of Canada; leader or president of a political party represented in a legislature; or mayor of any size municipality. A person ceases to be a domestic PEP 5 years after they are no longer a domestic PEP (including after death).

The **head of an international organization (HIO)** is a person who is either: the head of an international organization established by the governments of states or the head of an institution established by an international organization. When we refer to the head of an international organization or the head of an institution established by an international organization we are referring to the primary person who leads that organization, for example a president or CEO. A person ceases to be a HIO 5 years after they are no longer a HIO (including after death).

If a person is a foreign PEP, domestic PEP or HIO, then certain family members and close associates must also be regarded as PEPs or HIOs. These family members are: their spouse or common-law partner (including ex-spouses); their child; their mother or father; the mother or father of their spouse or common-law partner; and a child of their mother or father (sibling). Close associates are: their business partners, or who they beneficially own or control a business with; romantic partner (boyfriend, girlfriend, or equivalent); who they are in a financial transaction with; a prominent member of the same political party or union; serving as a member of the same board; closely carrying out charitable works with. Family members remain a PEP or HIO for the duration indicated above. Close associates remain a PEP or HIO until the relationship no longer exists.
